3 — Follow the on-screen instructions to set up your account. (**NOTE:** account data from the old FOSSweb has not been transferred, so you must create a new account):

- Register as a user within an organization if you work for a school or district.
- Use your school email address if possible. To find your organization, type one or more keywords, but not the entire name. If the system cannot find it, try changing your search criteria. Once found, click on the “Add” button next to your organization’s name.

- Create a password that is at least 8 characters long. Your password is case sensitive. Select two security questions that will be used if you forget your password.
- Submit your registration information. You will be sent a confirmation email shortly. You must click on the link the email to confirm your registration. (**Note:** You should receive this email very soon after registering. If you do not, check your spam box. The email will be from School Specialty.)

4 — Once you receive the confirmation email, click on the link to complete your registration. You will then be logged into the site.
