

Tobin K – 8 School Junior Scholars Program



The purpose of the **Tobin Junior Scholars Program** is to recognize and reward fourth and fifth grade students who have developed consistent habits of mind in their academic and social behavior while giving additional support and structure to students who need more help. A student's level of progress will be assessed in the categories listed below to determine their scholar status within a two-week interval based on a point system. All of the student's teachers will determine the student's scholar status. Every two-weeks student's will be assessed by the fourth or fifth grade team on their progress towards adherence to their community and academic responsibilities. Our goal is to have every student as a CEO Scholar.

Categories for Assessment:

- Attendance and Punctuality
- Classroom Behavior/Overall Conduct
- Classroom Transitions
- Class Participation
- Respect for Others/Respect for School Property
- Dress Code
- Homework Completion/Quality of homework

Please note that after an assessment by the fourth and fifth team the status of any student can be lowered within the two-week cycle.

MAC & TJX Scholars are expected to develop and implement a Scholar Improvement Plan in conjunction with their homeroom teacher and/or student support coordinator.

Points for Scholar Status:

- 0 – 4 **CEO Scholar**
- 5 – 7 **MAC Scholar**
- 8 – 10+ **TJX Scholar**

Description of Scholar Status:

- Modeling exemplary scholar behavior.
- Work out technical difficulties.
- Warning – Shop around for better choices.

Students receive a check mark for non-compliance of a specific category. Total numbers of check marks are tallied after a two-week cycle to determine each student's scholar status.
