Dear Parent/Guardian _____

Good afternoon. Your partnership is important and integral to our success each day, each week and throughout the school year. Safety is the most important priority of our school. As a parent and partner in our community, we ask that you take this opportunity to share with your child about the importance of safety and appropriate behavior on the school bus.

This letter is intended to serve as a transportation warning resulting from your child's behavior during either dismissal from 4:00-4:40pm or on the school bus during the course of this academic year. At this juncture in the school year, we have received multiple reports and/or write-ups resulting from your child's behavior and choices. These reports and/or write-ups include:

- Present in areas not assigned
- Running through hallways
- Word choice or inappropriate volume
- Physical contact with peer student(s)
- Physical contact with staff member
- Disrespect to the bus driver
- Standing up on school bus
- Leaving trash on bus floor or seat

Any additional write-ups by either the bus driver and/or staff during dismissal will result in the Denial of BPS Transportation.

As a reminder, the school bus is considered an "extension of the classroom" in terms of expected student behavior and choices that impact self and peers. Riding on BPS provided transportation is a privilege and not a right. Knowing this and knowing the impact that misbehavior on the bus has on the ability of transportation to function efficiently. Students must remain seated during the entire ride to and from school, respect and listen to the bus driver at all times, share ideas using appropriate language and to keep all hands within the bus and away from the school bus window. The safety of your child is the most important priority of our school.
