On attendance: as you know, Boston Public Schools are held accountable for student attendance. Students are expected to be in school each day. However, if a student has more than 3 absences per term, s/he is on a trajectory toward being considered "chronically absent" by the state. Learning time is lost when students are absent, no matter the reason; attendance is a crucial factor in determining how students perform in school.
